Foreword

Ripon Motorsports Club are proud to announce :

“The St Wilfrids Tour”

A navigational tour of the dales for cars built between 1900 and 2000

This will take place on Sunday 11th August and will start from Ripon and include a coffee halt, buffet lunch ,then dinner to finish in North Stainley near Ripon

Navigation will be in the form of a tulip road book with instructions and plotting points on Ordnance Survey Landranger Map 99 – don't worry it is very simple navigation. Rejoin Instructions in the form of map references will be included in the road book , to enable anyone who unfortunately become lost to enable them to regain the route.

We anticipate interest will be high and entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis and the entry form will be live on the RMSC web site www.riponmotorsportsclub.co.uk on the 1st July

We are limited to a maximum of 60 entries so getting in early would be a distinct advantage

The St Wilfrids Tour 2024 11.08.2024

1 Ripon Motor Sports Club will organise the St Wilfrids Tour on Sunday 11th August 2024. The route is approximately 120 miles through scenic North Yorkshire including the Dales and Nidderdale. Navigation by way of 'tulip' diagrams, spot height references, and map reference points – you will need the latest edition of OS Map 99 – a road book will also be provided

2 The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption issued by MSUK, these Regulations and any written instructions that may be issued for the event. The MSUK Permit/Certificate of Exemption for this event is No. TBC . First car will leave at 09.45 hours from Morrisons Supermarket , Harrogate road Ripon followed at 30 second intervals by all subsequent cars.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

3 This event is open to all historic and classic vehicles of make and model manufactured prior to 1999. However, if the 'entry' is not full we will open up to newer 'interesting or sport models' vehicles at the organisers discretion. (e.g. Lotus, Ferrari, Porsche etc).

4 All vehicles should be presented in good condition; the Organisers reserve the right to decline any vehicle showing damage. Each vehicle must be taxed for the road and have a valid MOT Certificate - if applicable.

5 Participating vehicles will be identified by a Rally Plate, supplied by the Organisers. This should be displayed in a prominent forward-facing position on the front of the vehicle. The Organisers reserve the right to exclude any vehicle which, in their opinion, is unsuitable for participation in the Tour. Vehicles must not carry any competition numbers anywhere on the vehicle.

INSURANCE

6 All entrants must ensure that their car has adequate insurance to enter the event. This being a Touring Assembly with a MSUK Exemption Certificate, their Public Liability Policy covers the event. However, this does not cover vehicle insurance under the Road Traffic Acts. A standard motor car policy may well cover the use of the car on a public highway. If in doubt, please seek advice from your insurance company.

ENTRIES

7 Entries open on Sunday the 1ST July 2024 and close on 20th July 2024, or before if maximum number of entries is met. Entry fee of £60 includes one Road Book, one souvenir Rally Plate + morning coffee + light lunch for two people, + dinner at the finish for both driver and navigator. Dinner will be at the Staveley Arms , North Stainley Ripon where the event finishes (extra meal tickets can be purchased via the entry form for £23.50 per person for extra passengers). Please indicate any dietary requirements on the entry form .Maximum number of entrants - 60. Over subscription will result in a Reserves List - if you are on the Reserves List, please do not pay your entry until a place is confirmed. In the unlikely event of the Tour being cancelled we will hold your entry and issue a new date.

8 TO ENTER

Entries can be made via a link on Ripon Motor Sports Club website <https://www.riponmotorsportclub.co.uk/st-wilfrids-rally> using the **rallies.info** entry system You will find the entry form under “St Wilfrids Rally” event page. Once you have completed an entry

form you will be given the details to enable BACS payment for your entry. Use your name as reference please. Entry is not complete until payment is made.

If you find any difficulty with any of this, please call the Entries Secretary once you have made your entry.

DOCUMENTATION

9, Car and crew should arrive at the Start – Morrisons Supermarket , Harrogate Road, Ripon HG4 2RU no later than 45 minutes before their due start time. The café will be open and fuel is available on site

10 Document Collection will take place in the Car Park of Morrisons Supermarket from 08.30. hrs where you will receive any amendments, your, Rally Plate and coffee/Lunch vouchers etc,

11 Parking during Document Collection will be directed by Marshals

ROUTE

12 The route will cover approximately 120 miles on asphalt roads, with directions in an easy to follow using tulip diagrams. A full Tulip Road Book will be provided. The mileages in the Road Book have been set using the “Rally Trip Meter” app trip meter. The Road Book will also contain written instructions and sundry information. A copy of Ordnance Survey Landranger map 99 will also be required for identifying rejoin points in the event of anyone becoming lost. The lunch stop is after approximately 70 miles, but prior to that there are several places en route for fuel, toilets, refreshments. There will be helpful instructions on how to follow Tulip diagrams in the final instructions for those who are not familiar with this kind of event.

13 The route takes in lots of country roads, narrow lanes etc. As ever, we ask you to be mindful of other road users, particularly cyclists, horse riders and walkers. We don't want to damage the reputation of Ripon Motor Sports club ! There is no average speed to keep to, please adhere to the Highway Code. Also please avoid driving in convoys!

14 There will be Observers throughout the route - to check you actually follow the correct the route, but also to check driving standards. Any reckless or unacceptable driving will result in disqualification from this event, and any future events run by Ripon Motor Sports Club.
